Admission Notice (Spot Admission)
B.A. Programme (FYUGP) – Session 2026–27

In continuation of the UG admission 2026 timelines and guidelines issued vide letter no: 75718/11/2026(i) dated 6th May, 2026, it is hereby notified that the Spot Admission process for vacant seats will be conducted from **15th to 17th June, 2026**, by **Bapujee College** via the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal.

Participation in this process strictly requires mandatory registration on the portal; in this regard, the following rules apply:

- Registered Applicants:** Candidates who have already registered on the admission portal and possess a valid Registration Number are not required to register again.
- Unregistered Applicants:** Candidates who have not yet registered on the portal may complete their registration from **13th June onwards until 17th June, 2026 (strictly up to 4:00 PM)**, prior to taking part in the Spot Admission process.

Rules and Regulations for Spot Admission, Session 2026-27

The following rules and regulations shall be followed during the Spot Admission process scheduled on **15.06.2026, 16.06.2026, and 17.06.2026** for admission into the First Year of FYUGP (B.A.) for the Academic Session 2026-27:

- The Spot Admission process will begin sharply at **10:00 AM** on the scheduled dates subject to the availability of vacant seats.
- All candidates seeking admission must report to the admission venue before the admission process begins.
- Before starting the admission process, the Admission Committee will announce the number of vacant seats available in each Major subject.
- Admissions will be conducted based on **merit and in order of reporting**. Candidates must remain present at the venue when their subject and percentage range are announced. Candidates who report after the admission process for their subject and percentage range is over will not be considered, even if they have a higher percentage.
- To ensure that no candidate misses the opportunity for admission, every announcement will be made three times before moving to the next stage.
- Subjects will be called in alphabetical order, such as Assamese, Economics, Education, English, Geography, etc.

7. When a subject is called:
- The number of vacant seats in that subject will be announced.
 - Candidates will then be called according to the following percentage ranges:
 1. Above 90%
 2. 80% to 90%
 3. 70% to 80%
 4. 60% to 70%
 5. 50% to 60%
 6. 40% to 50%

Note: If two candidates with the same percentage compete for a single seat, the candidate securing higher marks in the concerned subject (Major) shall be given preference.

8. When a particular percentage range is announced, candidates must report before the Admission Committee with all original documents and photocopies for verification.
9. Document verification and allotment of seats will continue simultaneously until all vacant seats in the concerned subject are filled.
10. Once all vacant seats in a subject are filled, admissions for that subject will be closed, and the Committee will move to the next subject following the same procedure.
11. The decision of the Admission Committee regarding eligibility, document verification, and allotment of seats shall be final and binding on all candidates.

6. Caste / Category Certificate (If applicable).
7. Bank Passbook: Original copy (Showing the front page with account holder details).
8. Gap Certificate (if applicable)
